

FRIENDSHIP QUILT
MAY 2004 - BLOCK OF THE MONTH

■ **Block size:** 12 inches

■ **Fabrics needed:** Three fabrics, a light, a medium and a dark BLUE.

CUTTING AND PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

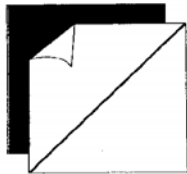
NOTE: The following cutting measurements include a 1/4-inch seam allowance.

- From the **light** fabric, cut:
 - * One 1 3/4-inch strip, 19 inches long.
 - * One 4 1/2-inch square.
 - * Two 4 7/8-inch squares.

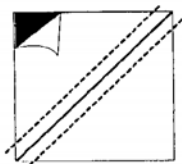
- From the **medium** fabric, cut:
 - * Two 1 7/8-inch strips, each 19 inches long.

- From the **dark** fabric, cut:
 - * Two 4 7/8-inch squares.

- On the two light 4 7/8-inch squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the fabric. Place each of these light squares atop a dark 4 7/8-inch square, right sides facing.



- Sew 1/4 inch on both sides of the line. Cut along the line.

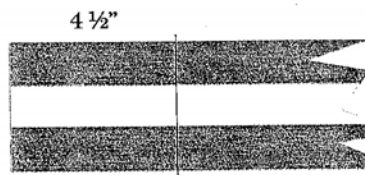


- **Unfold** and press toward the darker fabric.

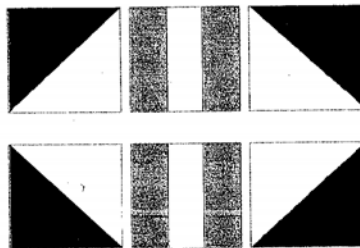
You will have four units that look like this. These are the corner units.



- Sew a medium strip to each side of the light strip. Subcut the unit into 4 1/2-inch pieces, making units that look like this:



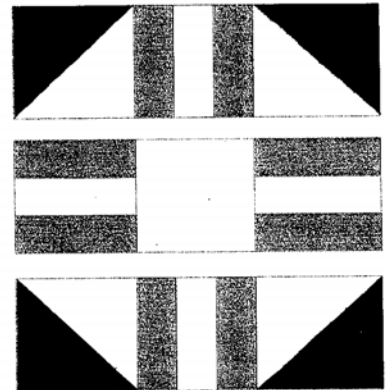
- Sew a corner unit to each end of one of the strip segments. Make two units like this:



- Sew a strip unit to two sides of the light square, making one unit that looks like this:



- **Assemble** the block as shown.



This block provides nine spaces for signatures.
