PUZZLE ME THIS - PASTEL BABY SAMPLER

BOM: OCTOBER 2007 - DUTCHMAN'S PUZZLE

To Rotary Cut Pieces:

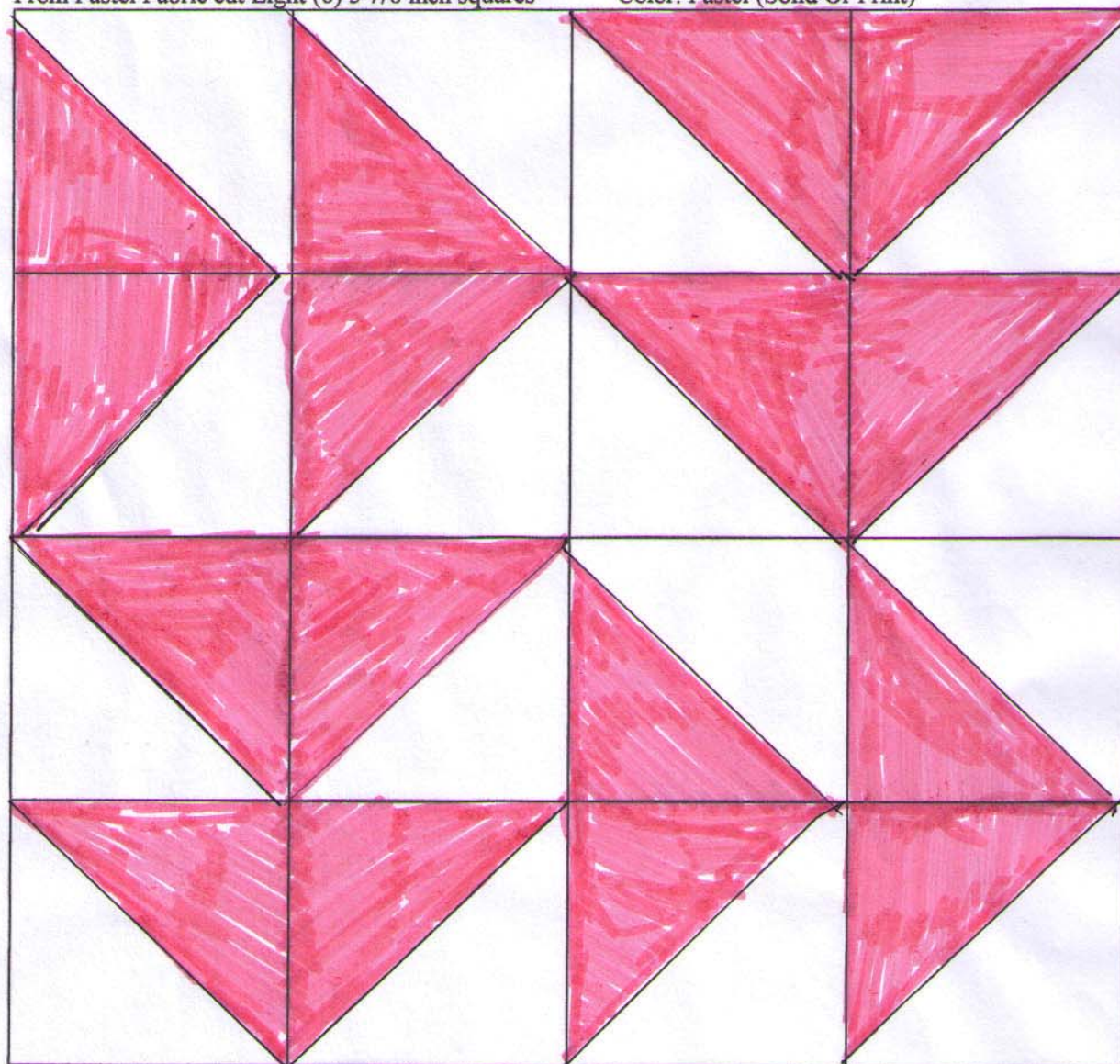
From White cut Eight (8)  $3 \frac{7}{8}$  inch squares

From Pastel Fabric cut Eight (8)  $3 \frac{7}{8}$  inch squares

Colors:

White

Color: Pastel (Solid Or Print)



Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each White  $3 \frac{7}{8}$  inch square. Place each White Square on top of a Pastel  $3 \frac{7}{8}$  inch square, right sides together

Step 2: Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch on either side of the diagonal line.

Step 3: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the Pastel Color fabric square. Make sixteen (16) half square triangle units.

Step 4: Sew the triangles together as shown in the diagram above.

Step 5: Press, trim to  $12 \frac{1}{2}$  inch square.
