



SIZE FINISHED: 12 inch block (12 ½ inches square with seam allowances)

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 1/4 inch seams

FABRIC COLORS:

Solid Black	
Solid Bright Color	

To Rotary Cut Pieces:

From Solid Black cut Two (2) 4 7/8 inch squares and Four (4) 4 ½ inch squares
 From Solid Bright Color cut Two (2) 4 7/8 inch squares and One (1) 4 ½ inch square

Piecing Instructions:

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Black square. Place each Solid Black Square on top of a Bright Color square, right sides together



Step 2: Stitch 1/4 inch on either side of the diagonal line.



Step 3: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the black fabric. Make four (4) half square triangle units.



Step 4: Sew the units created in Step 3 together to create the block shown in upper left corner of this page, using the four 4 ½ black blocks as cornerstones, and the 4 ½ inch solid bright color block as the center. Press, trim to 12½ inch square.
