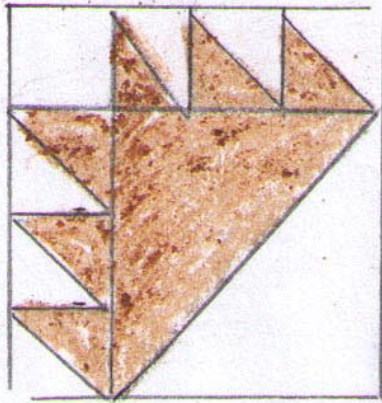


QGB BLOCK OF THE MONTH

AMERICAN HISTORY SAMPLER

March 2007 Block - Delectable Mountain



SIZE FINISHED: 12 inch block (12 1/2 inches square with seam allowances)

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 1/4 inch seams

FABRIC COLORS:

Brown - Solid or
Small Print



White - Solid or
Small Print



To Rotary Cut Pieces:

From White cut: Three(3) 3 7/8 inch squares, One(1) 3 1/2 inch squares and One(1) 9 7/8 inch square

From Brown cut: Three(3) 3 7/8 inch squares, One(1) 3 1/2 inch squares and One(1) 9 7/8 inch square

Piecing Instructions:

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each White 3 7/8 inch square. Place each White 3 7/8 inch square on top of a brown 3 7/8 inch square, right sides together

Step 2: Stitch 1/4 inch on either side of the diagonal line.

Step 3: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the brown fabric. Make six (6) half square triangle units.



Step 4: Using the directions in steps 1 through 3 above, Make two half squares triangle units from the brown and white 9 7/8 inch squares (only one of these half square triangle units will be used in this block, use the other for another project).

Step 5: Sew the pieces created in Step 3 and 4 together as shown in the diagram in the lower right corner of this page.

Step 6: Press, trim to 12 1/2 inch square.
