

A SAIL BOAT IN BLUE AND WHITE
 JUNE 2004 - BLOCK OF THE MONTH

■ **Block size:** 12 inches

■ **Fabrics needed:** Three fabrics, a **light**, a **medium** and a **dark BLUE**.

CUTTING AND PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: The following cutting measurements include a ¼-inch seam allowance.

■ From the **light** fabric, cut:

- * Three 3 7/8-inch squares.
- * Two 3 1/2-inch strips, each 6 1/2 inches long.

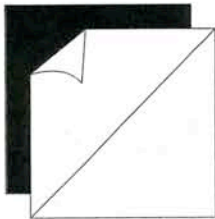
■ From the **medium** fabric, cut:

- * One 3 1/2-inch strip, 12 1/2 inches long.

■ From the **dark** fabric, cut:

- * Three 3 7/8-inch squares.
- * One 3 1/2-inch strip, 6 1/2 inches long.

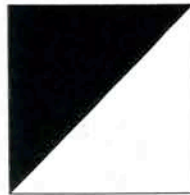
■ **Draw** a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the light 3 7/8-inch squares. Place each light 3 7/8-inch square atop each dark 3 7/8-inch square, right sides facing.



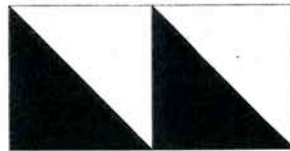
■ **Sew** 1/4 inch on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the line.



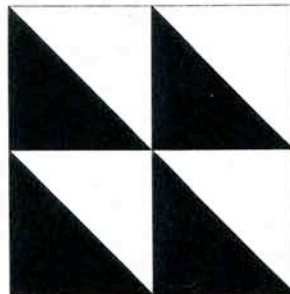
■ **Unfold** and press toward the dark fabric. You will have six half-square units that look like this:



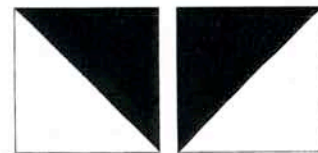
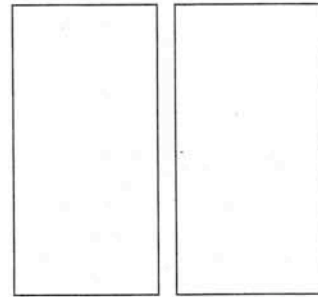
■ **Sew** four half-square units together as shown.



■ **Sew** the dark strip to the half-square units.



■ **Sew** the remaining two half-square units to each light 6 1/2-inch strip as shown.



■ **Assemble** the units and the remaining medium strip as shown.
