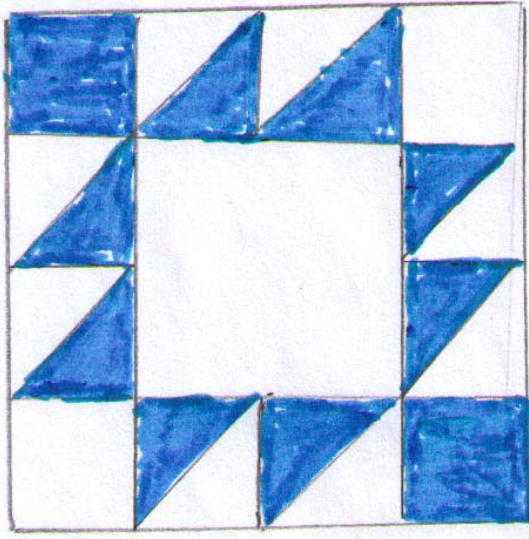


QGB BLOCK OF THE MONTH

AMERICAN HISTORY SAMPLER

May 4, 1626 - Canarse Indians sell Manhattan Island to the Dutch for \$24

May 2007 BOM - Indian Block



SIZE FINISHED: 12 inch block (12 ½ inches square with seam allowances)

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 1/4 inch seams

FABRIC COLORS:

Blue - Solid or
Small Print



White - Solid or
Small Print



To Rotary Cut Pieces:

From White cut: Four (4) 3 7/8 inch squares, Two (2) 3 ½ inch squares and One (1) 6 ½ inch square

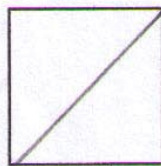
From Blue cut: Four (4) 3 7/8 inch squares and two (2) 3 ½ inch squares

Piecing Instructions:

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each White 3 7/8 inch square. Place each White 3 7/8 inch square on top of a blue 3 7/8 inch square, right sides together

Step 2: Stitch 1/4 inch on either side of the diagonal line.

Step 3: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the blue fabric. Make eight (8) half square triangle units.



Step 4: Sew the half square triangles units together into four two half square triangle sets

Step 5: Sew a blue 3 ½ inch square to one end of each of two of the sets made in step 4.

Sew a white 3 ½ inch square to the other end of each of these sets.



Step 6: Sew one of the remaining two half square triangle sets to each side of the 6 ½ inch square

Step 7: Sew one of the strips made in Step 5 to the top and one to the bottom of the unit made in Step 6 as in the diagram in the upper right corner of this page.

Step 8: Press, trim to 12 ½ inch square.
