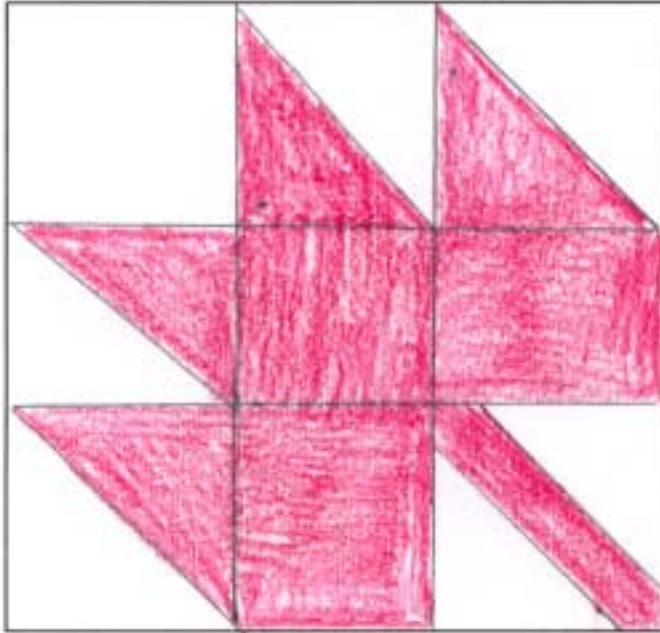


QGB BLOCK OF THE MONTH

OCTOBER 2005 - Maple Leaf



SIZE FINISHED: 12 inch block (12 1/2 inches square with seam allowances)

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 1 1/4 inch seams

FABRIC COLORS:

Solid Black



Solid Bright
Color



To Rotary Cut Pieces:

From Solid Black cut Two (2) 4 7/8 inch squares and One (1) 4 1/2 inch square
From Solid Bright Color cut Two(2) 4 7/8 inch squares and Three (3) 4 1/2 inch squares
and One (1) strip from Bright Solid Color 1 1/2 by 7 inches.

Piecing Instructions:

Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Black square. Place each Solid Black Square on top of a Bright Color square, right sides together



Step 2: Stitch 1/4 inch on either side of the diagonal line.



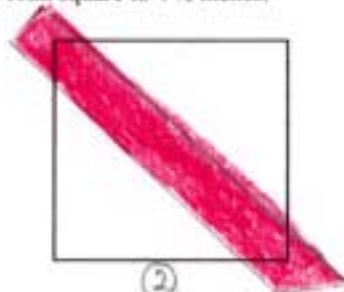
Step 3: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the black fabric. Make ten (10) half square triangle units.



Step 4: To make stem block:(1) Cut one solid black 4 1/2 inch square diagonally. (2) Stitch the 1 3/4 inch strip to either side of the diagonal of triangle. (3) Trim square to 4 1/2 inches.
