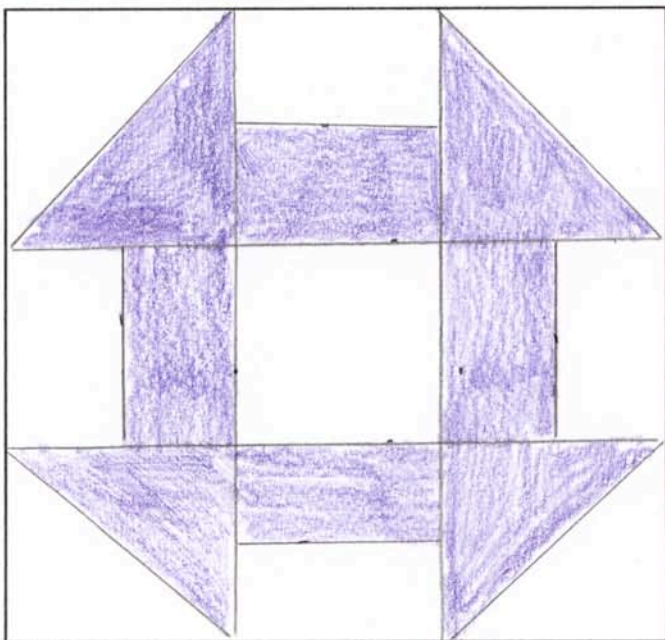


QGB BLOCK OF THE MONTH

SEPTEMBER 2005 - Churdash



SIZE FINISHED: 12 inch block (12 ½ inches square with seam allowances)

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 1 ¼ inch seams

FABRIC COLORS:

Solid Black



Solid Bright
Color



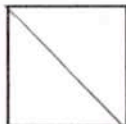
To Rotary Cut Pieces:

From Solid Black cut: One (1) 4 ½ inch square; Two (2) 4 7/8 inch squares; & Four (4) 4 ½ by 2 ½ inch rectangles

From Solid Bright Color cut: Two (2) 4 7/8 inch squares and Four (4) 4 ½ by 2 ½ inch rectangles.

Piecing Instructions:

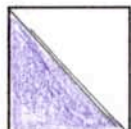
Step 1: Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Black square. Place each Solid Black Square on top of a Bright Color square, right sides together



Step 2: Stitch ¼ inch on either side of the diagonal line.



Step 3: Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the black fabric. Make four (4) half square triangle units.



Step 4: Stitch each black rectangle to a solid color rectangle (using ¼ inch seam). Make four (4) rectangle units.



Step 5: Sew the units created in steps 3 and 4 together to create the block shown above.
