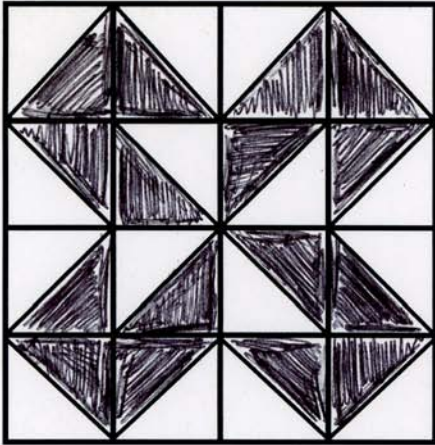


QGB Block of the Month



To Rotary Cut Pieces:

Step 1. From the medium and dark scraps, cut:

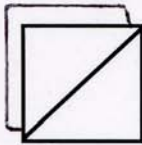
- eight $3 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares

Step 2. From the white-on-white (or off-white) scraps, cut

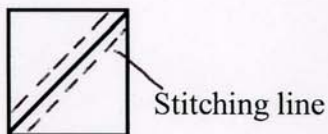
- eight $3 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares

Piecing instructions:

Step a. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each dark square. Place each dark square on top of a light square, right sides together.



Step b. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ in. on either side of the diagonal line



SEPTEMBER 2004: Jack in the Box

Size Finished: 12-inch block ($12 \frac{1}{2}$ inches square with seam allowances)

Seam Allowance: $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seams

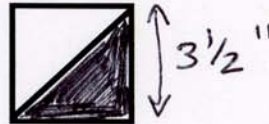
Fabrics / Colors:

(8) Medium – Dark Scraps (at least $3 \frac{7}{8}$ ” square) – PREWASHED

(8) White on white (or off-white) scraps (at least $3 \frac{7}{8}$ ” square) - PREWASHED

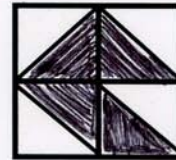
Piecing instructions (continued):

Step c. Cut along the diagonal line and press the seam to the dark fabric. Repeat until you have 16 half square triangle units like this



Make 16

Step d. Sew the half square triangle units created in step c to create 4 units as illustrated:



Make 4

Step e. Sew the units created in Step d together to create the block shown in the upper left corner of this page. Press, trim to $12 \frac{1}{2}$ in. square.
