Look for twelve 12 " blocks all based on an animal theme. We flutter into summer with a butterfly. We're excited to be your hosts this year! ~Robin Engleman \& Joy West

## Fabrics \& Cutting

Background: Any light color fabric, solid or minimal print to contrast with the butterfly
6-3" squares
2-3 $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Draw a diagonal sewing line on each of the squares from corner to corner.
$1-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $w$ by 2 " $h$ rectangle
$1-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} w$ by $3^{\prime \prime} h$ rectangle
Body: Contrast with background and wings
$1-1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ w by $81 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{h}$ rectangle
Wings: Cheerful colors (Great use for prints!)
2-6"w by 7"h rectangle - upper wings
2-6" squares - lower wings

## Sewing instructions

All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.

## STEP 1: Body

- Sew the two rectangles to each end of the body and press seams toward the dark. (The longer 3" end is the top of the butterfly.)


## STEP 2: Upper Wings

- It is important to place the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
 on the top - one goes on the top left \& one top right. Then sew the remaining $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares on opposite bottom corners. Trim the corner seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.



## STEP 3: Lower Wings

Place two 3" squares on opposite corners of each of the lower wings as shown. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim the corner seam allowance to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.


## Sewing instructions (Cont.)

## (Cont.)

- Press the corner seams in the upper and lower wings in opposite directions (one set in and one out) This will let the seams nest when sewn together, reducing bulk.


## STEP 4: Assembly

- Sew the upper and lower wings together matching the corners as shown.
- Sew the left \& right wing pairs to the body and press in towards the body.


## STEP 5: Finishing

- You can embroider antennae on the top of the body in a contrasting
 color if you choose.

Finished block should measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inch square. ( 12 " block with $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance all the way around.)
