June 2023 Block of the Month • BROOKLYN QUILTERS GUILD By Eleanor Lutz




Fabrics & Cutting

Flower (scrappy, colorful fabrics suggested)
A: 8x Petals, 4x4in.
B: 2x Center, 5.5x5.5in.

Leaves & stem (green fabric suggested) C: 2x Stem, 1.5x6in. D: 4x Leaves, 2.5x2.5in.

Background (light fabric suggested)
E: 4x Rectangles, 2.5x6in.
F: 1x Center strip, 1x11in.






Instructions

All seam allowances are ¹/₄in. Finished block is 11x11in.


1: Draw one diagonal line on the back of each leaf (**D**) and petal (**A**) in washable marker or chalk.



2: Sew one flower petal (\mathbf{A}) onto each flower center (\mathbf{B}) , following the diagonal line you drew earlier. Trim and iron.



3. Going counterclockwise around the flower center, continue to sew one flower petal (A) onto each corner of B. Trim and iron after finishing each petal.



4: Sew one leaf (\mathbf{D}) onto each of the background rectangles (\mathbf{E}) . Two of them should be sewn on the right side, and two on the left. Trim and iron flat.

5. Sew one leaf section onto each side of the stems (C).

6: Iron again. Sew the flower heads onto the stem sections, then sew both flowers together with the center strip (\mathbf{F}) in between.

The finished block should be 11 inches square, including seam allowance.

This block is the final block of the month this year! I'll share instructions for a complete B.O.M. throw quilt at our next guild meeting. Thanks for sewing along!

Bring your block to our next guild meeting to enter the lottery and win that month's collection of blocks! If you can't come to the meeting, you can enter by sharing your block on our B.O.M.
